She has handled every creative and technical aspect of media production during her decades-long career. Writing, directing, and producing her own projects as well as others. Those who have worked with Arlette praise her enthusiasm, energy, and compassion.

Arlette Thomas-Fletcher was the president of Women in Film and Video of Maryland. While president, she coordinated and served as WIFV-MD Chapter Event Coordinator for the Maryland Film Festival premier event, for now, Academy Award winner and Oscar-nominated cinematographer Ellen Kuras' film "The Betrayal" and film director Zoe Cassavetes' film "Broken English". She has produced more than 30 short films which have been featured at numerous film festivals.

Arlette's 2022 western, Christian feature film, "The Lonesome Trail" was released in July 2022 on Amazon Prime, Apple TV, Dish TV, Comcast, Verizon FIOS, and all VOD platforms. The film was produced from "The Lonesome Trail" a novel written by Arlette Thomas-Fletcher and is also on Blu-ray disc and DVD. "The Lonesome Trail" has won 18 awards, been featured in Charisma Magazine, and has been accepted to the International Christian Film and Music Festival where it was nominated for Most Inspirational Film.

"The Lonesome Trail" screenplay won Best Screenplay and Screenplay Finalist awards from the Christian Film Festival, Sunny Side Up Film Festival, and The Wild Bunch Film Festival, among others. It also won Best Trailer at The International New York Film Festival.

Arlette has written two screenplays that were featured in Spotlight on Screenwriters script magazine. A collaborative screenplay called "The Key" and another screenplay called "Daddy Where Are You?"

Her first short award-winning film was called "Assault in Brooklyn" which has won a Silver Telly Award and an Accolade award. To name a few other short films she produced were "The Mystery Date" and "Blessing in The Storm" which were streamed and featured on ROKU TV and 24Flix. Arlette has also produced music videos, including videos for artist Joel Brian Thomas' songs "God Has My Back" and "Blessing in The Storm." Other music video credits include "You're Not Alone", "When We Struggle", "Let Me Go", "Fire Inside Me", "Like A Star" and many more.

Her work has been featured at the Christian Film Festival, the Inspired Faith Film Festival, Great Lakes Christian Film Festival, Baltimore Women's Film Festival, Attic Film Festival, Torpedo Factory Art Center Female Shorts & Film, and Video Showcase, The Phoenix International Christian Film Festival, and World Music Independent Film Festival.


Her natural love of film led her to create her own projects with her production partner, Clairvoyance Co-Founder, and life partner, Shaquille Pariag.
